

## PROSECUTION

<b>Summary</b>	Telford Steam Railway were fined for criminal breaches of health and safety law, which left a member of its staff with extensive injuries. The incident occurred when a 450kg length of rail was moved from a wagon to the trackside by a crane, and struck a member of staff, who suffered extensive injuries to both legs.
