THIS 43RD TG SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT is dated 8th October 2012 and made between:

- (1) <u>NETWORK RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE LIMITED</u> a company registered in England under number 2904587 having its registered office at Kings Place, 90 York Way, London N1 9AG ("Network Rail"); and
- (2) <u>STAGECOACH SOUTH WESTERN TRAINS LIMITED</u>, a company registered in England under number 599788 having its registered office at Friars Bridges Court, 41-45 Blackfriars Road, London, SE1 8NZ (the "Train Operator").

WHEREAS:

- (A) Network Rail and the Train Operator entered into a Track Access Contract (Passenger Services) dated 20th May 2004 in a form approved by ORR pursuant to section 18(7) of the Act, (which track access contract is hereafter referred to as the "Contract").
- (B) The parties now propose to enter into this Supplemental Agreement to vary the Contract in the manner and on the terms set out below.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:

1. **INTERPRETATION**

In this Supplemental Agreement:

- (A) Words and expressions defined in and rules of interpretation set out in the Contract shall have the same meaning and effect when used in this Supplemental Agreement except where the context requires otherwise; and
- (B) "Effective Date" means the later of:
 - (1) the date of signature of this Supplemental Agreement; and
 - (2) 14 October 2012.

2. **EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM**

The amendments to the Contract as set out in this Supplemental Agreement shall have effect from the Effective Date and shall cease to have effect on the Expiry Date or earlier termination of the Contract.

3. OFFICE OF RAIL REGULATION GENERAL APPROVAL

This Supplemental Agreement is entered into pursuant to paragraphs 11 and 12 of the Passenger Access (Short Term Timetable and Miscellaneous Changes) General Approval 2009.

4. <u>AMENDMENTS TO THE CONTRACT</u>

4.1 Appendix 7C of Schedule 7 (Default Train Consist Data) shall be amended by the deletion of the row relating to Train Service Code 24676004 and its replacement as follows:

Train Service Code	Type of Train Movement	Default Train Consist Data
24676004	Train movements of empty coaching stock along the routes	2 Class 450 Electric Multiple Unit (2 x motor coaches and 2 x trailers each)

4.2 Appendix 1 to Schedule 8 shall be amended as follows:

- (A) By the deletion of that part of the table relating to Service Group HY01 Main Suburban Off Peak and its replacement as set out in Annex A to this Supplemental Agreement;
- (B) By the deletion of that part of the table relating to Service Group HY01 Main Suburban Peak and its replacement as set out in Annex B to this Supplemental Agreement; and
- (C) By the deletion of that part of the table relating to Service Group HY06 Windsor Outers Off Peak and its replacement as set out in Annex C to this Supplemental Agreement.

5. **EFFECT OF THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT ON THE CONTRACT**

The Contract, as amended by this Supplemental Agreement, shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with its terms, and during the period in which the amendments made by this Supplemental Agreement are to have effect all references in the Contract to "the contract", "herein", "hereof", "hereunder" and other similar expressions shall, unless the context requires otherwise, be read and construed as a reference to the Contract as amended by this Supplemental Agreement.

6. THIRD PARTY RIGHTS

No person who is not a party to this Supplemental Agreement shall have any right under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 to enforce any term of this Supplemental Agreement.

7. **LAW**

This Supplemental Agreement shall be governed by, construed and given effect to in all respects in accordance with English Law.

8. **COUNTERPARTS**

This Supplemental Agreement may be executed in two counterparts which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same document. Either party may enter into this Supplemental Agreement by signing either of such counterparts.

IN WITNESS whereof the duly authorised representatives of Network Rail and the Train Operator have executed this Supplemental Agreement on the date first above written.
