Summary	Breaches of health and safety law that led to two rail workers being seriously injured when carrying out repairs to a ballast regulator.
Company	Babcock Rail and Swietelsky Construction
Breaches involved	Health and Safety At Work etc. Act 1974, section 2(1) and 3(1).
Date(s) of offence	25th March 2009
Plea	Guilty
Result	Babcock Rail and Swietelsky Construction pleaded guilty and were fined at Cambridge Crown Court on 19 April 2013
Penalty	£24,000 (Swietelsky Construction) £36,000 (Babcock Rail)
Costs	£13,000 (Swietelsky Construction) £16,728.17 (Babcock Rail)
