

PROSECUTION

Summary	On 11th June 2008, three Network Rail employees were injured when a mobile elevated work platform on which they were working, during the repair of damaged overhead lines on an area of track near Margaretting in Essex, detached. They were thrown to the ground. One of the three, Malcolm Slater, later died from his injuries.
