Summary	Network Rail's failure to provide and implement suitable and sufficient standards, procedures, guidance, training, tools and resources for the inspection and maintenance of fixed stretcher-bar points led to a train derailing at Grayrigg, causing the death of one passenger and injuring 86 people.
