

## PROSECUTION

<b>Case number</b>	4081894
<b>Summary</b>	During overnight work to upgrade the West Coast Main Line, the overhead line remained live as the companies involved had not ensured a safe system of work. Despite warnings about their isolation procedures from their own safety staff, no improvements were made resulting in an employee of Elec-Track Installations suffering burns after receiving an electric shock from the overhead line.
