APPROVAL OF PROPOSALS FOR CHANGE 109-112 RELATING TO PART D (TIMETABLE CHANGE) AND PART R (ACCESS DISPUTE RESOLUTION RULES) OF THE NETWORK CODE

- The Office of Rail and Road (ORR) has today approved Proposals for Change (PfC) 109-112 to the Network Code, which were submitted to it by the Class Representative Committee (CRC) on 3 May 2022. These proposals, sponsored by Network Rail Infrastructure Limited, amend Part D and Part R of the Network Code.
- 2. ORR has reviewed the consultation responses received and considered by the CRC at its meeting on 13 April 2022. The CRC approved PfCs 109-112 at its meeting on 13 April 2022. ORR has approved the proposals because it is satisfied that the changes will ensure that Part D and Part R of the Network Code is clearer and reflects up to date practices. The approval of PfCs 109-112 is consistent with ORR's section 4 duties.
- 3. In accordance with Condition C9.1.2 of the Network Code, the amendments to Part D shall have effect 14 days from the date of this notification.
- 4. In giving CRC notice of approval ORR also copies this letter and attached notice to all parties identified under Condition A4.1 of the Network Code.
- 5. A copy of this letter, the approval notice and marked up copies of Part D and Part R of the Network Code, showing all the proposed changes, will be placed on the ORR website. A copy of the approval notice will also be placed on the ORR's public register.
