Hi Jonathan,

Thank you for your e-mail.

We note the update provided by the former franchise operator on 17th November where it is confirmed the Kenilworth service will not be proposed for Sunday operation and also that there will be a delay in providing a Class 172 train to operate the service. Whilst the former point is helpful the latter is a concern and we are unclear when and if the Class 172 will be provided. We note Warwickshire County Council's announcement but it does not alter the matters pertaining to the railway operation proposed.

The letter does not address all of the points of concern that we raised back in August 2017:

- Have the promised infrastructure improvements been delivered to support performance over the route with the new service?
- Has the network-wide impact of deteriorating CrossCountry performance been properly taken into
 account and modelled? It is a fact that delays to our services spread delay across the network which
 must be a serious concern given the current concern expressed about railway punctuality by
 Department for Transport and ORR.
- Have Network Rail's action plans to address the poor performance over the whole CrossCountry
 route to help operation of a reliable Kenilworth service been articulated? Network Rail's track
 record in clearly defining such plans has in our experience been highly inconsistent, something we
 have raised repeatedly. We do not believe that 'every attempt' has been made to address these
 performance shortcomings (as suggested in the October letter).

We are keen that the new service commences operation but must equally insist that commitments to actions to mitigate the risk to existing services are properly followed through and we trust that progress in this regard will form part of your ongoing assessment of the access application.
