Consent to a supplement to the Track Usage Price List: Box Wagons FSAO and JPAE

1. The Office of Rail and Road has today issued a Notice of Consent to a Supplement to the Track Usage Price List, submitted to us by Network Rail Infrastructure Limited 10 March 2020, and subsequently confirmed by Freightliner Heavy Haul Ltd by email on the same date. This letter sets out the reasons for our decision.

Purpose of the change

2. The purpose of the supplement is to amend the Variable Usage Charge (VUC) rates section of the Track Usage Price List, for the purpose of the track access contract, to include FSAO and JPAE vehicle types conveying domestic waste and construction materials.

ORR review

3. These vehicles are not on the CP6 pricelist for the commodities concerned. The new CP6 VUC rate has been agreed between the parties, using the same data as for the CP5 rate, and calculated using the CP6 VUC calculator.

4. These amendments shall have retrospective effect from the first date these vehicles were used on the Network or 1 April 2019, whichever date is later.
