Consent to a supplement to the list of capacity charge rates: Govia Thameslink Railway Limited (GTR)

- 1. We have consented to supplement the list of capacity charge rates in an application dated 1 September 2017 and re-submitted to us by the above on 18 September 2017 under Paragraph 9.4(c) of Part 2 of Schedule 7 to their track access contract.
- 2. The purpose of this application is to supplement the list of capacity charge rates to reflect the addition of three new train service codes into the parties' track access agreement to enable the introduction of Class 700 Thameslink units on existing Southern routes.
- 3. There is no requirement for industry consultation in this matter as no other train or freight operating company are affected by the changes.
