## Railway Safety Regulations 1999: Regulation 3

## **Certificate of Exemption**

- 1. The Office of Rail Regulation (ORR) exempts under regulation 6(1) of the Railway Safety Regulations 1999 (the Regulations) **Network Rail Limited (Company Number 04402220)** (the company) from the requirements applicable to an infrastructure manager of regulation 3(1) of the Regulations for the prohibition of the operation of a train on a railway unless a train protection system is in service in relation to that train and railway. In granting this exemption, ORR has consulted as required by regulation 6(2) and had regard to the matters set out in regulation 6(3) of the Regulations.
- 2. This exemption applies to the operation of Great Western Steam Railmotor (vehicle number 99093) (the Railmotor) without a train protection system and applies only when the Railmotor is being operated under its own traction and in isolation from any other vehicle on the Looe Valley Branch Line between Liskeard and Looe.
- 3. This exemption is valid from 31 October 2012 until 31 October 2013.
- 4. Under regulation 6(1) of the Regulations, ORR may revoke the whole or any part of this exemption, at any time, in writing.
