## Top 10 stations in Great Britain

Top 10 most heavily used stations in Great Britain based on estimates of entries/exits between 1st April 2013 and 31st March 2014

The estimates are derived from ticket sales data recorded in rail industry systems and certain train operators (primarily Eurostar and Heathrow Express) are not recorded in these systems and therefore not included in the estimates.

Estimates are included for travel undertaken using zonal/multi-modal tickets sold by Strathclyde Partnership for Transport and the English Integrated Transport Authorities along with Travelcards in the London area.
