Consent to a Supplement to the Track Usage Price List: IDAQ wagons

1. On 6 May 2015 the Office of Rail Regulation (ORR) issued a Notice of Consent to a Supplement to the Track Usage Price List submitted to us by Network Rail on 19 March 2015 under Paragraph 2.2 of Schedule 7 to the Track Access Contract (TAC) between Network Rail Infrastructure Limited (Network Rail) Direct Rail Services Limited (DRS). The purpose of this letter is to set out the reasons for our decision.

Purpose of the change

2. The purpose of this supplement is to amend the Freight Variable Use Charge rates section of the Track Usage price List to include details for the IDAQ wagon vehicle operated by DRS.

3. There is no requirement for industry consultation in this matter with the only regulatory process becoming applicable when the parties to the contract disagree.
